HOW SHOULD WE STAFF HIEs?

A new study by AHIMA and the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society (HIMSS), "Trends in HI Organizational Staffing/Part 2: A Deeper Look at Staffing Challenges," looks at roles in health information exchange organizations—connectivity, data integrity, and data integration—that were identified in a 2014 survey as difficult to fill and maintain. The report looks at representative job titles, educational requirements, experience, and may serve as a guide to both hiring managers and potential candidates. Among the findings were that these roles appear to earn more than they did in 2012 and that HIOs primarily recruit through referrals, industry conferences, and events.






